



Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Olson, who asked for unanimous consent to consider HSB 508 in subcommittee as a whole. There were no objections. Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Olson for opening comments on HSB 508. Following discussion, HSB 508 passed out of subcommittee as a whole by a voice vote. Then, motion was made and duly passed to dissolve the subcommittee as a whole and return to committee. Then Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Olson for opening comments on HSB 508. There being no discussion, Representative Olson moved for passage of HSB 508. HSB 508 passed the committee 17-3, with 1 absent. Chairperson Swaim announced that HSB 508, having received sufficient votes, would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.

Chairperson Swaim then recognized Representative Lensing for opening comments on HSB 545. Following discussion, Representative Lensing moved passage of HSB 545. HSB 545 passed the committee 19-1, with 1 absent. Chairperson Swaim announced that HSB 545, having received sufficient votes, would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.

Democrats and Republicans went to caucus.

Democrats and Republicans returned from caucus and the House Judiciary Committee meeting recessed at 2:55 p.m.

The House Judiciary Committee meeting reconvened at 3:40 p.m.

Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Olson, who corrected his opening comments on HSB 508, which were made before the bill passed. The committee was offered the opportunity to reconsider votes, with none reconsidering.

Chairperson Swaim then recognized Representative Olson for opening comments on HF 2235. Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Olson for opening comments on Amendment 502 to HF 2235. Representative Olson then asked for unanimous consent to withdraw all other amendments except Amendment 502. There were no objections. Following discussion, Representative Olson moved passage of Amendment 502. Amendment 502 passed by a voice vote. Chairperson Swaim then recognized Representative Olson for opening comments on HF 2235. Following discussion, Representative Olson moved passage of HF 2235 as amended. HF 2235 passed the committee 17-3, with 1 absent. Chairperson Swaim announced that HF 2235, having received sufficient votes, would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.

Chairperson Swaim then recognized Representative Palmer for opening comments on HSB 776. The Chair recognized Representative Anderson, who moved for unanimous consent to consider HSB 776 in subcommittee as a whole. There were no objections. Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Palmer for opening comments. Following discussion, HSB 776 passed out of subcommittee as a whole by a voice vote. Then, motion was made and duly passed to dissolve the subcommittee as a whole and return to committee. Chairperson Swaim then recognized Representative Palmer for opening comments on HSB 776. Following discussion, Representative Palmer moved passage of HSB 776. HSB 776 passed the committee 20-0, with 1 absent. Chairperson Swaim announced that HSB 776, having received sufficient votes, would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.
