The meeting was called to Order at 3:05.

The roll call was taken.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The chair assigned the following bills:

HF 2519 - Wendt, Ch. Cohoon, May - A bill for an act providing for a committee to study an open eligibility policy for certain students in grades seven through twelve relating to competitive high school activities, and providing an effective date.

SF 2329-Wendt, Ch. Gayman, Tymeson - A bill for an act providing that funding of teacher compensation, professional development, early intervention, and educational excellence phase II be implemented through the school aid formula on a per pupil basis. (Formerly SSB 3187.)

SF 2251-Staed, Ch. May, Wendt - A bill for an act relating to student eye care and including an applicability date provision.

Democrats and Republicans caucused.

Democrats and Republicans returned from caucus.

Rep. May moved to recess at 4:30 P.M.

The chair called the meeting to order at 10:05 P.M.

The chair recognized Rep. Winckler for consideration of SF 2216, A bill for an act concerning state and local measures for preparing a student for a career or for postsecondary education, including a statewide core curriculum for school districts and accredited nonpublic schools and a state-designated career information and decision-making system. (Formerly SSB 3097.)

The chair recognized Rep. Raecker for consideration of amendment 709 to SF 2216.

Rep. Raecker moved amendment 709 to SF 2216, and requested a Roll Call Vote.

Amendment 709 to SF 2216 failed, 10 ayes, 12 nays, 1 absent.

The chair recognized Rep. Winckler for consideration of amendment 513 to SF 2216.

The chair recognized Rep. Chambers for consideration of amendment 711 to

amendment 513 to SF 2216.

Rep. Chambers moved amendment 711 to amendment 513 to SF 2216, and requested a roll call vote.

Amendment 711 to amendment 513 to SF 2216 failed, 11 ayes, 12 nays and 0 absent.

Rep. Raecker requested a division to amendment 513, dividing amendment 513 to SF 2216 into Division A, page 1, lines 3-18 and page 1, lines 23 through the remainder of the amendment, and division B, page 1, lines 19-22.

Rep. Winckler moved division A, short form. Division A was adopted.

Rep. Raecker moved division B of amendment 513, and requested a roll call vote.

Division B passed 12 ayes, 11 nays, and o absent. With the adoption of divisions A and B, amendment 513 passes.

The chair recognized Rep. Raecker for consideration of amendment 710 to SF 2216.

Rep. Raecker moved amendment 710 to SF 2216, and requested a roll call vote.

Amendment 710 to SF 2216 failed, 11 ayes, 12 nays, and 0 absent.

The chair recognized Rep. Mascher for consideration of amendment $514\ \text{to}\ \text{SF}\ 2216$.

Rep. Mascher moved amendment 514 to SF 2216, short form.

Amendment 514 to SF 2216 passed.

Rep. Winckler moved SF 2216 as amended by 513 and 514.

SF 2216 as amended by 513 and 514 passed, 14 ayes, 9 nays, 0 absents.

SF 2216 as amended by 513 and 514, having received a constitutional majority moved to the house floor as senate file.

Chairman Wendt relinqushes his gavel to Vice-Chairwoman Mascher for consideration of a bill.

Temporary chair (Mascher) recognized Rep. Wendt for consideration of SF 2329, A bill for an act providing that funding of teacher compensation, professional development, early intervention, and educational excellence phase II be implemented through the school aid formula on a per pupil basis.
