Chairwoman Lensing called the meeting to order at 7:30 am. Roll was taken.

Representative Lensing introduced and briefly discussed Amendment 301, to HSB 788. Republicans and Democrats caucused.

Representative Lensing yielded the Chair to Representative Ford. Representative Ford recognized Representative Lensing for consideration of HSB 788- A study bill relating to student loans, including the protection of students and parents from certain lenders and institutions of higher education with conflicts of interest, establishing a student lending education fund, establishing penalties, and providing for related matters. Opening remarks and discussion followed.

Representative Ford recognized Representative Lensing for consideration of Amendment 301. Opening remarks were given and Representative Lensing moved the amendment. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

Discussion ensued and Representative Lensing was recognized for final remarks on HSB 788. The bill passed as amended with a vote of 5 ayes, 4 nays, 0 absent.

An Oversight House meeting to discuss SF 2403, an act concerning the ability of the lottery authority to operate a joint lottery with a lottery operated outside of the United States, later in the week was discussed. Representative Swaim moved to arise and the meeting adjourned at 8:40 am.
