Seeing a quorum, Chairperson Bolkcom called the meeting to order at 1:05 pm.

The secretary called the roll and the minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

Senator Bolkcom announced that a list of sub-committee assignments had been distributed.

Senator McCoy took the chair and recognized Senator Bolkcom who introduced SSB 3286. Senator Bolkcom gave a brief description of the study bill and introduced amendment 3286.501. Senator Bolkcom described the amendment.

The meeting stood at ease at 1:15 pm for a Democratic and Republican caucus.

The meeting resumed at 1:40 pm. Following discussion, a record vote was called, and the amendment passed 9-7 with 1 voting present. Discussion followed on SSB 3286 as amended. Following discussion, a record vote was called and the study bill passed 9-7 with 1 voting present. The committee waives rule 40 and the bill moves to the calendar as a Committee Bill.

Senator Bolkcom resumed the chair and recognized Senator Dotzler for SF 595. Senator Dotzler gave a description of the bill and introduced amendment 595.202. Senator Dotzler gave a description of the amendment. There being no discussion, short form was called, and the amendment passed unanimously. There being no discussion on the bill as amended, short form was called and SF 595 as amended passed unanimously. The committee waives rule 40 and the bill moves to the calendar as a Committee Bill.

Senator Bolkcom recognized Senator Dotzler for HF 2589. Senator Dotzler gave a description of the bill. Following discussion, a record vote was called and the bill passed 10-7. The bill moves to the calendar as a Committee Bill.
