Chair Mertz then recognized Representative Olson for opening remarks on HF 2692. Representative Kuhn presented Amendment 202 to FH 2692. Discussion followed.

At 6:05 pm, the meeting again reconvened.

Discussion continued on Amendment 202 to HF 2692. Representative Kuhn offered closing remarks on Amendment 202 and requested a roll call vote, Representative Frevert seconded. Results of the record roll call are as follows: Ayes (6) - Whitaker, Frevert, Kuhn, H. Miller, Swaim, and Zirkelbach. Nays (15) - Mertz, Drake, Davitt, DeBoef, Dolecheck, Gayman, Greiner, Huseman, S. Olson, Rayhons, Reasoner, Reichert, Struyk, Wenthe, and Worthan. Amendment 202 failed to pass.

Representative Greiner was recognized for opening remarks on Amendment 701 to HF 2692. Following discussion, Representative Greiner moved the amendment. The amendment passed with a voice vote.

Representative Olson was recognized for closing comments on HF 2692. A record roll call was taken and Hf 2692 as amended passed, 21-0. HF 2692 will now move to the House Floor as an Leadership Bill with an amendment.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Struyk moved that the Ag Committee adjourn.
