House File 41 was assigned to Beard-CH, Thede, and Arnold. House File 42 was assigned to Whitaker-CH, Steckman, and Baudler.						
Representative Bell turned the chair of the meeting over to Representative Beard in order to take up House Joint Resolution 1. Representative Beard then recognized Representative Bell to introduce HJR 1. HJR 1 would constitutionally protect funds for natural resources. There was a discussion and questions among the members. HJR 1 passed by a vote of 21-0. Representative Beard then turned the committee chairmanship back over to Representative Bell.						
There was a presentation by Dale Garner, Wildlife Chief at the Department of Natural Resources. The presentation centered around the current problems facing upland game birds, particularly pheasants. Mr. Garner then fielded questions with his colleague Ken Herring.
