The House Judiciary Committee was called to order at 3:10 P.M. in Room 102 by Chairperson Swaim.

Roll was taken, Chairperson Swaim declared a quorum was present and the minutes from the previous meeting were approved as previously distributed.

Chairperson Swaim distributed and assigned the following bills:
HSB 139 - Swaim-Chair, Palmer, Kaufmann

Chairperson Swaim re-assigned the following bills:
HSB 80 - Palmer- Chair, Swaim, Horbach

Republicans and Democrats went to caucus.

Upon reconvening Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Wessel-Kroeschell for opening comments on HSB 28. Following opening comments and committee discussion, Representative Wessel-Kroeschell moved passage of HSB 28. Chairperson Swaim announced the results of the vote. HSB 28 passed the Judiciary Committee 11-9, with 1 absent. Chairperson Swaim announced that the bill having received sufficient votes for passage would pass to the floor of the House as a committee bill.

By unanimous consent, consideration of HSB 48 was deferred.

By unanimous consent, consideration of HF 85 was deferred.

There being no further business to come before the committee, motion was made by Representative Anderson for the committee to arise.
