Senator Kreiman called the meeting to order at 4:05 pm. Minutes of the February 2nd meeting, electronically sent, were approved. Both parties went to caucus, returning at 4:25 pm.

Sen. Kreiman recognized Sen. Jochum for SF 22. Opening remarks were given. Shortform was called for and SF 22 was adopted as a committee bill under Rule 40 on a vote of 14 ayes and 1 excused.

Senator Quirnbach was recognized for SF 70 and distributed amendment 70.701. A sense amendment was offered to delete the word "child" in line 4. The sense amendment was withdrawn, and amendment 70.701 was adopted. SF 70, as amended, was approved under Rule 40 on a vote of 14 ayes and 1 excused.

Sen. Kreiman turned the Chair over to Sen. Hogg, who called upon Sen. Kreiman for SSB 1032. Amendment 1032.301 was distributed and adopted. SSB 1032, as amended, was approved 14 ayes and 1 excused as a committee bill under Rule 40. Sen. Hogg returned the Chair to Sen. Kreiman.

Senator Fraise and committee of Senators Hancock and Noble reported recommendation of Governor appointee, David Lorenzen. The appointment was give Committee approval and will now move to the enbloc calendar.

Sen. Zaun moved to adjourn at 4:40 pm.
