HSB 166, An Act relating to the eligibility for tax credits and income reductions for qualified expenditures under the film, television, and video project promotion program and providing effective and retroactive applicability date provisions, was assigned to Rep. Miller, chr.; Rep. Marek and Rep. Cownie.

Rep. Thomas recognized Rep. Ford for opening comments on HSB 21. Following discussion on the bill, Rep. Ford was recognized for closing remarks. Rep. Ford moved HSB 21. The bill having received sufficient votes for passage will move to the floor of the House as a committee bill. Ayes - 17, Nays - 0, Absent - 4.
