Chairperson Oldson called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Roll was called; a quorum was present. Members not in attendance at the time were excused until their arrival. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The meeting was recessed at 5:35 pm for caucuses by both parties. The meeting reconvened at 6:05 pm.

Chairperson Oldson asked Representative Wenthe to take the chair. Chairperson Wenthe asked for and received unanimous consent for the committee to meet as a committee of the whole.

Chairperson Wenthe asked recognized Representative Oldson for consideration of HSB 212, an act relating to public funding and regulatory matters and making, reducing, and transferring appropriations and revising fund amounts and including effective, retroactive, and other applicability date provisions. Representative Oldson explained the proposed legislation.

Chairperson Wenthe recognized Representative Oldson for consideration of amendment 301. Representative Oldson explained the amendment and moved its adoption. Short form was requested. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

Chairperson Wenthe recognized the following Representatives for comments and questions on HSB 212: Raecker and Roberts. Chairperson Wenthe recognized Representative Oldson for closing remarks on HSB 212. Representative Oldson moved that HSB 212 be amended and sent to the committee for further consideration. Short form was requested. The motion was adopted.

Chairperson Wenthe asked for and received unanimous consent to return to the full committee. Chairperson Wenthe recognized Representative Oldson for opening comments on HSB 212. Chairperson Wenthe recognized Representative Oldson for amendment 301. Representative Oldson moved the amendment. Short form was requested the amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

There was no discussion on the legislation as amended. Chairperson Wenthe recognized Representative Oldson for closing comments on HSB 212.
