Senator Bolkcom was recognized for SF 170 and amendment 170.201. The amendment passed by voice vote and Senator Bolkcom moved the bill. A roll call vote was asked for. The bill passed with 11 Ayes, 3 Nays and 1 Absent and moves to the Senate Calendar as an Approved Committee Bill under rule 40.
