The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Representative Gaskill. Roll was called with a quorum being present.

There being no additions or corrections to the minutes of the previous meeting, they were approved as received electronically.

The following bills were assigned:

SF 434: A bill for an act relating to nuisance properties by requiring the indexing of certain municipal citations and petitions affecting real property. Huser Ch, Isenhardt, Tjepkes

SF 343: An Act relating to local regulation of certain lawn applications. Olson Ch, Whitead, Windschitl

The Democrats and Republicans went to caucus.

The meeting reconvened. Representative Huser was recognized for opening remarks on SF 434: A bill for an act relating to nuisance properties by requiring the indexing of certain municipal citations and petitions affecting real property. Representative Huser was recognized for opening remarks on amendment 434.502. The amendment passed short form.

After discussion and questions, Representative Huser moved the bill for adoption. The bill passed unanimously. It will go to the floor of the House as a Senate file with a committee amendment.

Representative Schueller was recognized for opening remarks on SF 441: A bill for an act relating to local emergency management by modifying provisions of the statewide mutual aid compact and by making changes to certain funding provisions. Discussion and questions were held.

Representative Huser was recognized for amendment 441.702 and asked for a division of the amendment. Without objection, to the Division of 441.702, Representative Huser withdrew Division B. Lines 3-9. Representative Huser moved the adoption of Division A, Lines 1 and 2 and lines 10 and 11. Passed short form.

Representative Windschitl was recognized for Amendment 441.201 and moved adoption. Passed, short form.

Representative Windschitl was recognized for Amendment 441.503 and moved to withdraw with no objections.

Representative Schueller was recognized for closing sstatements and moved adoption of the bill. SF 441 passed unanimously and will go to the floor of the House as a Senate file with a committee amendment.

Representative Gaskill asked for unanimous consent to consider SF 343: A bill for an act relating to local regulation of certain lawn applications in subcommittee as a whole. Representative Huser objected and therefore the bill was not considered .

There being no other business Representative Huser moved adjournment. The meeting was adjourned.
