Chairman Thomas called the meeting to order. Roll call was taken and the minutes from the previous meeting were approved as printed. Rep. Thomas recognized Rep. Miller for opening remarks on [SF 403](#), a bill for an act concerning the sale of beer by native wineries. There was an amendment. Rep. Miller spoke on Amendment 201. With no questions on the amendment, Rep. Miller moved Amendment 201. It passed by voice vote. Following discussion on the bill, Rep. Miller was recognized for closing comments. Rep. Miller moved the bill. [SF 403](#) passed unanimously as amended. Ayes - 18, Nays - 0, Absent - 3. Rep. Thomas recognized Rep. Thede for opening remarks on [SF 207](#), a bill for an act relating to the Iowa finance authority by providing immunity for board members, providing administrative authority for the executive director, eliminating duties of the council on homelessness, defining projects under the bond bank program, and defining assets in, and providing for the use of moneys in, the housing trust fund. Following discussion on the bill, Rep. Thede was recognized for closing comments. Rep. Thede moved the bill. [SF 207](#) passed unanimously. Ayes - 19, Nays - 0, Absent - 2. Rep. Thomas asked for unanimous consent to consider [SF 304](#) as a subcommittee as a whole. There were no objections. Rep. Thomas recognized Rep. Soderberg for [SF 304](#), a bill for an act relating to withholding agreements and local match requirements of the targeted jobs withholding tax credit program. Following discussion on the bill, [SF 304](#) passed out of subcommittee by voice vote. Rep. Thomas moved to dissolve subcommittee on [SF 304](#). There were no objections. Rep. Soderberg was recognized for opening comments on [SF 304](#). With not further questions on the bill, Rep. Soderberg was recognized for closing comments. Rep. Soderberg moved the bill. The [SF 304](#) passed with sufficient votes. Ayes - 18, Nays - 1, Absent 2. With no further business to come before the committee, Rep. Forristall moved to adjourn. Meeting adjourned.
