Chairperson Oldson recognized Rep. Taylor for SF 475, the justice budget. Rep. Taylor explained the legislation. Chairperson Oldson recognized Rep. Taylor for amendment 701. Rep. Taylor explained the amendment and moved its adoption. Short form was requested. Amendment 701 was adopted on a voice vote.

Chairperson Oldson announced that the committee was on SF 475 as amended. Chairperson Oldson requested that Rep. Raecker be excused for the remainder of the meeting (at 2:10 pm). Chairperson Oldson recognized the following representatives for questions and comments: Alons, Heaton and Worthan.

Chairperson Oldson recognized Rep. Taylor for final remarks on SF 475. Rep. Taylor moved that SF 475 be sent to the House with a recommendation of amend and do pass. Roll was called.
