The House Judiciary Committee was called to order at 1:10 p.m. in Room 102 by Chairperson Swaim.

Roll was taken and a quorum was present.

Next, Chairperson Swaim reassigned the following bill:

HSB 589 - Huser-CH, Struyk, Mertz

Republicans and Democrats went to Caucus.

Upon Reconvening Chairperson Swaim temporarily assigned Vice-Chair Palmer as Chairperson.

Chairperson Palmer then recognized Representative Swaim for opening comments on HSB 558. After opening comments, Chairperson Palmer recognized Representative Swaim for opening comments on Amendment 267 to HSB 558. After opening comments, Representative Swaim moved passage of Amendment 267. The amendment passed by a voice vote. Chairperson Palmer then recognized Representative Swaim for final comments on HSB 558, as amended. Representative Swaim then moved passage of HSB 558, as amended. HSB 558 passed the Judiciary Committee 20-0, with Representative Anderson absent and not voting. Chairperson Palmer announced that HSB 558, having received sufficient votes for passage, would pass to the floor of the House as a committee bill.

Chairperson Palmer then returned Chair duties to Representative Swaim.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Representative Mertz moved to arise.

The committee adjourned at 1:45 p.m.
