Senator Kreiman called the meeting to order at 4:05 pm. Both parties went to caucus, returning at 4:25 pm.

Sen. Kreiman recognized Senator Schoenjahn for SSB 3108, who explained the bill. Shortform was requested. SSB 3108 was approved to become a Committee bill and will be placed on the Senate Calendar.

Sen. Kreiman turned the Chair over to Senator Hogg who recognized Sen. Kreiman for HF 758. HF 758 passed out of subcommittee "without recommendation"; Senator Kettering abstaining from signing the subcommittee report. Record roll call was called for "without recommendation" resulting in passage of the bill on a vote of 9 Ayes, 5 Nays, and 1 pass. Sen. Hogg returned the Chair to Sen. Kreiman.

Senator Jochum was called upon by Sen. Kreiman for a report on Governor appointee Keith Johnson to the Civil Rights Commission, stating approval from the subcommittee. Approval was given by the Committee. The appointment of Keith Johnson will move to the en bloc on the Senate Calendar
