Chairman Thomas called the meeting to order. Roll Call was taken and the minutes from the previous meeting were approved as printed.

The following bills were assigned: HSB 580, Rep. Thomas, chr.; Rep. Forristall, Rep. Jacoby HSB 783, Rep. Ford, chr.; Rep. Kelley, Rep. Sorenson

Both parties caucused on the bills to be considered.

After caucus, Chairman Thomas recognized Rep. Jacoby on HF 2082, a bill for an act providing for a tax credit against the individual and corporate income taxes, the franchise tax, insurance premiums tax, and the moneys and credits tax for a charitable contribution to certain institutions engaged in regenerative medicine research and including a retroactive applicability date provision. Both Rep. Jacoby and Rep. May made opening comments on the bill. There was an amendment. Rep. Jacoby moved Amendment 442. Amendment 442 passed by voice vote. Rep. Jacoby and Rep. May were recognized for closing comments on the bill. After discussion, Rep. May moved HF 2082. HF 2082 passed with sufficient votes as amended, as a committee bill to Ways & Means. Ayes: 19, Nays: 2, Absent: 0.

Chairman Thomas recognized Rep. Bailey for opening comments on HSB 670, a study bill concerning allowable locations for holders of a class "E" liquor control license. There was an amendment. After discussion on Amendment 553, Rep. Bailey moved the amendment. Amendment 553 passed by voice vote. Rep. Bailey was recognized for closing comments on HSB 670. After discussion on the bill, Rep. Bailey moved HSB 670 as amended. The bill passed with sufficient votes as amended, as a committee bill to the floor. Ayes: 13, Nays 8, Absent: 0
