Representative Lensing called the Government Oversight Committee meeting to order on February 4th, 2010 at 10:05 a.m.

The roll was taken and minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Representative Lensing introduced Mary Neubauer, Vice President of External Relations for Iowa Lottery. Mary Neubauer introduced Terry Rich, CEO of Iowa Lottery who presented. Mr. Rich discussed the Lottery's FY 2011 Budget and new developments, including Iowa's participation in a multi-jurisdiction lottery and promotions that will encourage tourism and travel to attractions in other Iowa communities. Mr. Rich announced the Iowa Lottery will see a 1% growth and had completed and passed an audit. In addition, the Iowa Lottery would like to invest in more electronic gaming, which will increase revenue and reduce Iowa Lottery expenses for paper tickets.

Mr. Rich opened the floor for questions and a discussion followed.

Representative Lensing introduced Barbara Vos, E911 Program Manager for Homeland Security & Emergency Management. Mrs. Vos discussed the E911 quarterly report and update for the fourth quarter. Mrs. Vos announced that a federal grant had been awarded from the Federal Department of Transportation. She explained that the award had allowed increased wireless network capacity for pinpointing 911 callers, especially those communities that border the state of Iowa.

Mrs. Vos opened the floor for questions and a brief discussion followed.

Representative Lensing announced the next meeting date for the week beginning February 15th, 2010.

Representative Berry moved to arise and the meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
