Upon return, Representative Gaskill announced that HSB 635: A study bill relating to the determination of city population for purposes of civil service commissions is being withdrawn.

Representative Gaskill recognized Representative Whitead for HF 2143: A bill for an act relating to prohibited contracts and activities for civil service commissioners. Opening remarks were given and Representative Whitead was recognized for amendment 2143.411. Following opening remarks he moved passage of the amendment short form. The amendment passed unanimously. He moved passage of the bill. It passed unanimously, Kuhn absent, and will become a committee bill as amended.
