Chairman Thomas called the meeting to order. Roll Call was taken and the minutes from the previous meeting were approved as printed.

The following bills were assigned:

HSB 725: Rep. Wenthe, chr., Rep. Steckman, Rep. Schultz - An Act relating to the allocation of moneys under the grow Iowa values fund for purposes of making grants to certain microenterprise development organizations.

HF 2352: Rep. Bailey, chr., Rep. Anderson, Rep. Marek - A bill for an act relating to the allocation of moneys under the grow Iowa values fund.

Chairman Thomas turned the chair position over to Rep. Ford.

Chairman Ford recognized Rep. Thomas for opening remarks on HF 2370, a bill for an act relating to enterprise zones by extending the application deadline for certification of enterprise zones and by updating certain fiscal year limitations. After discussion on the bill, Rep. Thomas was recognized for closing comments. Rep. Thomas moved the bill. HF 2370, having sufficient votes for passage moves to the House floor, as an individually sponsored bill. Ayes: 20, Nays: 0, Absent 1.

Chairman Ford turned the chair position back to Rep. Thomas.

Both parties agreed to go to caucus on the next bill to be considered.

After return of caucus, Chairman Thomas turned the chair position over to Rep. Ford.

Chairman Ford recognized Rep. Thomas for opening comments on HSB 680, a study bill for authorizing creation of consumption tax bonding districts and providing for the issuance of bonds secured by certain tax revenues collected within a district. There was an amendment. Rep. Thomas was recognized for Amendment 1009. Rep. Thomas moved the amendment. Amendment 1009 passed by voice vote.

The chair position was turned back to Rep. Thomas. Chairman Thomas deferred on HSB 680 until the next meeting.

With no further business to come before the committee, Rep. Thede moved to adjourn. The meeting adjourned.
