Voting aye from the House were Representatives Winckler, Hanson, Ficken, Frevert, and Wenthe. Invoking House Rule 27 from the House were Representatives Dolecheck, Chambers, Koester, and May.

The motion passed the Senate 3 - 2 and passed the House 5 - 4.
