The House Judiciary Committee was called to order at 2:30 P.M. in Room 102 by Chairperson Swaim. Roll was taken, a quorum was present and the minutes of the previous meeting were approved as distributed. Next, Representative Swaim announced the assignment of bills to the following subcommittees: [SF 2343](#) - Swaim -CH, Palmer, Helland [SF 2351](#) - Lensing -CH, Schulte, Smith [SF 2298](#) - Swaim -CH, Huser, Schultz [SF 2200](#) - Swaim-CH, Huser, Schultz [SF 2306](#) - Swaim -CH, Mertz, Schulte [SF 2252](#) - Ford -CH, Schulte, Swaim [SF 2302](#) - Swaim -CH, Mertz, Schulte Chairperson Swaim then temporarily assigned Vice-Chair Palmer as Chairperson. Next, Chairperson Palmer recognized Representative Swaim for opening comments on [SF 2200](#). Following opening comments, Chairperson Palmer recognized Representative Swaim for opening comments on Amendment 4738 to [SF 2200](#). After opening comments, Representative Swaim moved passage of Amendment 4738. The amendment passed by a voice vote. Chairperson Palmer then recognized Representative Swaim for final comments on [SF 2200](#), as amended. [SF 2200](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 16-0, with Representatives Horbach, Struyk, Smith, Baudler and T. Olson absent and not voting. Chairperson Palmer announced that [SF 2200](#), having recieved sufficient votes for passage, would pass to the Floor of the House as a Senate File. . Chairperson Palmer then recognized Representative Swaim for opening comments on [SF 2298](#). Following opening comments and committee discussion, Chairperson Palmer recognized Representative Swaim for final comments on [SF 2298](#). [SF 2298](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 19-0, with Representatives Smith and R. Olson absent and not voting. Chairperson Palmer announced that [SF 2298](#), having recieved sufficient votes for passage, would pass to the Floor of the House as a Senate File. Chairperson Palmer then returned Chair duties back to Representative Swaim. There being no further business to come before the

committee, motion was made by Representative Mertz for the committee to arise. The committee adjourned at 3:00 P.M.
