The House Natural Resources Committee was called to order by Representative Bell. Roll call was taken and a quorum was present. The minutes of the last meeting were approved. Representative Bell recognized Representative Beard for opening remarks on [SF 2216](#): A bill for an act allowing certain game birds to be shot when released on a licensed hunting preserve and providing a penalty. There was a question by Representative Baudler. Representative Beard then gave closing remarks on [SF 2216](#) and moved the bill. A roll call vote was taken and [SF 2216](#) passed to the floor of the House with 19 ayes, 1 nay and 1 absent.
