Quirk then moved the bill. Roll was called, and the bill passed 22-0, with all present voting aye. The bill will pass to the House floor as a Senate file. Rep. Petersen recognized Rep. Andrew Wenthe for an introduction of [SF 2346](#). Rep. Wenthe introduced Amendment 2346.1861. Following discussion, Rep. Wenthe offered closing comments and moved the amendment. Amendment 2346.1861 passed on a voice vote. Rep. Petersen opened the floor to discussion of [SF 2346](#), as amended. There was no discussion, and Rep. Petersen recognized Rep.
