McCarthy and Paulson. The committee was asked to address the issue of "the manner in which elected legislators may vote on bills or amendments" from the floor.							
Representative Pettengill was recognized and stated that this was a matter for the House Rules Committee. She added that the House Ethics Committee should address issue during the next session.							
Representative Tymeson was recognized stating that $SR58$, which gives clarity on who can use the voting mechanism. She added the issue of undue pressure on legislators by other legislators on the floor and in committee meetings be looked into.

Representative Olson recommended that we advise House leadership to request that the Administration and Rules Committee adopt language similar to SR58 "only members may operate the electronic voting machine".							
Representative Olson recommended that House leadership ask the Rules and Administration committee to adopt language similar to Senate Rule 58 stating "only members may operate the electronic voting machine".
