Chair Baudler called the meeting to order at 3:05PM.

Roll call was taken, and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments, and/or deletions to the January 25th meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Subcommittees are assigned as follows:

HSB 36 was assigned to a subcommittee of Representative Windschitl as chair, Representative Hagenow, Representative Baudler, Representative Olson R., and Representative Kressig.

HSB 37 was assigned to a subcommittee of Representative Windschitl as chair, Representative Shaw and Representative Olson, R.

The meeting recessed at 3:10PM, and both Republicans and Democrats of the committee held a short caucus. The meeting reconvened at 3:30PM.

The chair recognized Representative Sands for opening remarks on HSB 4. It is a study bill relating to the control of marijuana, including an effective date provision, and providing a penalty. Representative Sands moved the bill. HSB 4 was voted on. This bill passed unanimously 21-0. This bill will move to the House floor as a Committee bill.

The chair recognized Representative Sands for opening remarks on HSB 5. This is a study bill for adding hallucinogenic substances to the list of schedule I controlled substances, providing penalties, and including an effective date provision. Representative Sands then gave opening remarks on Amendment 244, a technical amendment for HSB 5. The Amendment 244 passed unanimously 21-0. After answering questions from the committee regarding this study bill, Representative Sands moved HSB 5. HSB 5 was voted on and passed unanimously 21-0 and will be moved to floor as a Committee bill.

As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Olson, R. moved we adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 3:40PM.
