The House Judiciary Committee was called to order at 3:15 PM in Room 102 by Chairperson Anderson.

Roll call was taken and Chairperson Anderson declared a quorum was present.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as previously distributed.

Chairperson Anderson distributed and assigned the following bills:

Republicans and Democrats went to caucus on HF 58 at 3:20 P.M. The House Judiciary was reconvened at 3:22

Chairperson Anderson recognized Representative Garrett for opening comments on HF 58. Discussion followed. Representative Garrett was recognized for closing remarks on HF 58. Representative Garrett then moved passage of HF 58. HF 58 passed the Judiciary Committee 19-0, with 2 absent.

Chairperson Anderson announced that HF 58 having received a constitutional majority, would pass to the Floor of the House as a Committee Bill.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Representative Hagenow moved to adjourn.
