The State Government Committee was called to order by Chair Cownie. Roll call was taken with a quorum present and Jorgensen and Quirk were excused.

The minutes of the January 31st meeting were approved as printed.

Chair Cownie announced the following bill assignments:

HF - 155 Helland/Chair; Rogers and Lensing
HF - 157 Kaufmann/Chair; Raecker and Gaskill

Chair Cownie announced HF 12 on today's agenda and both parties went to caucus at 2:10 p.m.

The committee reconvened at 2:33 p.m.

Representative Hein was recognized to take up HF 12. A bill for an act to prohibit political telephone calls during the nighttime hours and making penalties applicable. The subcommittee report of Hein, Isenhardt and Koester was submitted and signed. Representative Hein gave opening remarks and asked permission to take up Amendment 278, discussion followed, amendment 278 was adopted.

Representative Hein was recognized for Amendment 231. Opening remarks were made, a discussion was held, and the amendment 231 failed on a roll call vote: 8 ayes 13 nays 2 absent.

Representative Hein gave closing remarks and moved HF 12 as amended as a committee bill on a roll call vote: 8 ayes 13 nays 2 absent.

Chair Cownie announced Donna Mueller from IPERS will be here for a presentation at the next meeting.

With no further business Chair Cownie moved to adjourn. Representative Drake seconded the motion.
