The meeting convened at 2:05.

Attendance was taken.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

The committee went into caucus at 2:10 and reconvened at 2:28.

Representative Forristall (Ch) recognized Representative Byrnes for opening remarks on HSB 47 (a study bill relating to the exercise by school districts of any broad and implied powers except as expressly prohibited by the Constitution of the State of Iowa or by statute). Representative Byrnes offered Amendment 344 and was recognized by Representative Forristall (Ch) for opening remarks. After discussion Representative Byrnes presented final comments and moved the amendment for passage. It passed on short form.

Representative Forristall recessed the meeting at 2:55.

The meeting reconvened at 4:17 for discussion on HSB 47. Representative Forristall (Ch) recognized Representative Byrnes for closing comments on the bill. Representative Byrnes moved the bill.

The result of a roll call vote on HSB 47 was 13 Ayes, 8 Nays, and 2 absent. The Ayes were Representatives Forristall, J. Taylor, Byrnes, Chambers, Cownie, Dolecheck, Hanusa, Jorgensen, Koester, L. Miller, Pearson, Schulte, and Sweeney. The Nays were Representatives Willems, Abdul-Samad, Cohoon, Gaines, Hanson, Mascher, Steckman, and Winckler. Representatives Kelley and Lofgren were absent for the vote.
