Representative Garrett moved passage of SF 72. SF 72 passed the Judiciary Committee 16 aye to 4 nay, with 1 absent. Voting nay were Representatives Pearson, Alons, Hagenow and Heaton. Chair Anderson announced that SF 72 having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as Senate File 72.
