Chair Baudler called the meeting to order at 1:05PM.

Roll call was taken and a quorum was present. Representative Swaim and Representative Olson, R. were excused.

As there were corrections/additions to the February 10th minutes, Chair Baudler announced the changes. The corrected draft was unanimously approved.

Subcommittees were assigned as follows:

HF 231 was assigned to a subcommittee of Representative Hagenow as chair, Representative Fry, and Representative Berry.

HF 276 was assigned to a subcommittee of Representative Tjepkes as chair, Representative Baudler, and Representative Kressig

HSB 95 was assigned to a subcommittee of Representative Shaw as chair, Representative Fry and Representative Olson, R.

Both Republicans and Democrats of the committees held a short caucus, and the meeting came to order again at 1:30PM.

The chair recognized Representative Windschitl for opening remarks on HSB 18. This is a study bill relating to the regulation of firearms and ammunition in a state of public emergency and providing a remedy. After yielding to questions, Representative Windschitl moved the bill. HSB 18 was voted on. This bill passed 14-5. Those voting nay were as follows: Representative Abdul-Samad, Representative Berry, Representative Gaines, Representative Kressig, and Representative Muhlbauer. This bill will move to the House floor as a Committee bill.

As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Olson, S. moved we adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 1:35PM.
