Chair Representative Sands called the meeting to order at 4:10 PM Attendance was taken and quorum was present. As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the February 14th meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved. The following bills were assigned: [HSB 104](#) Pettengill- Chair, Byrnes and Quirk [HSB 105](#) Helland- Chair, Soderberg and Quirk [HF 211](#) Sands- Chair, Pettengill and Willems [SF 209](#) Subcommittee of the Whole [HSB 129](#) Sands-Chair, Helland, Kaufmann, Jacoby and Kearns The committee dissolved into Committee of the Whole for Consideration of [SF 209](#). The meeting recessed for both parties to caucus. When the committee resumed, Jim McNulty with the Department of Revenue gave an explanation of the bill and the effects of the amendments. The bill was moved and passed on a voice vote. The Committee reconvened. The Chair recognized Representative Vander Linden for opening remarks on [SF 209](#). This is a bill relating to public funding and regulatory matters by making appropriations, providing for updated Code references to the Internal Revenue Code, increasing the state earned income tax credit. Chairman Sands recognized Representative Vander Linden for an introduction of Amendment 566. The Chair then recognized Representative Jacoby for an introduction of Amendment 586 to Amend 566. A Division and record was requested on Amendment to the Amendment 586. Roll call vote: Ayes were Jacoby, Isenhardt, Kajtazovic, Kearns, Muhlbauer, Oldson, Petersen, Quirk, Thomas, and Willems. Nays were Sands, Byrnes, Cownie, De Boef, Forristall, Grassley, Hein, Helland, Kaufmann, Paustian, Pettengill, Soderberg, J. Taylor, & Vander Linden. The Amendment to the Amendment failed Aye: 10 Nay: 14. The Amendment 566 was then voted on passed on a voice vote. [SF 209](#) was then voted on as amended. The bill passed by a vote of 17-7. The Nays were: Jacoby, Isenhardt, Kajtazovic, Kearns, Oldson, Petersen and Willems. The bill

is now referred to the Appropriations Committee. As there was no additional business to come before the committee Representative Quirk moved to adjourn at 5:35 PM.
