The House Judiciary Committee was called to order at 1:04PM in Room 102 by Chairperson Anderson.

Chair Anderson recognized Representative Baltimore for opening comments on HSB 64. Following opening comments, Chair Anderson recognized Representative Baltimore for opening comments on Amendment .462. As there was no discussion, Representative Baltimore moved Amendment .462 to HSB 64. The amendment passed unanimously by voice vote. Discussion on HSB 64 as amended followed. By unanimous consent, Kevin Cmelik, Director of Criminal Appeals Division in the Attorney General's Office, was recognized for comments and to answer questions. Following discussion, Representative Baltimore was recognized for closing remarks on HSB 64. Representative Baltimore moved passage of HSB 64 as amended. HSB 64 passed the Judiciary Committee 15-6. Those voting no were Representatives Lensing, Oldson, Olson, R., Olson, T., Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wolfe.

Chair Anderson announced that HSB 64 having received a constitutional majority, would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.

Chair Anderson announced that members would be going to their respective caucuses following adjournment.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Representative Tjepkes moved to adjourn.
