Chair Tjepkes called the meeting to order. Roll was taken and a quorum present.

Chair Tjepkes reconvened the meeting and recognized Rep. Watts for opening remarks on HSB 93, an act relating to the use of automated traffic enforcement systems. Rep. Watts introduced Amendment 838 and gave his opening remarks. Following discussion, Amendment 838 passed short form on a voice vote.

Rep. Watts was recognized for closing remarks. He moved passage of HSB 93 as amended, which passed the Transportation Committee with a vote of 20 yea 0 nay. Chair Tjepkes announced that HSB 93 as amended, having received a constitutional majority, would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Rep. Pearson moved we adjourn.
