The Economic Growth/Rebuild Iowa Committee convened at 5:05 PM. Roll call was taken at the start of the meeting. Chair Grassley asked for any revisions to the previous meetings minutes. Hearing none, Chair Grassley moved to approve the minutes and the motion was unanimously carried.

Chair Grassley assigned the following bill assignments:
HF 183 to Schultz (Chair); De Boef, Jacoby
HF 394 to Schultz (Chair); Hanusa, Heddens
HF 413 to Soderberg (Chair), Lofgren, Thomas

Chair Grassley turned the Chair over to Representative Hanusa. Acting Chair Hanusa recognized Representative Grassley for opening remarks on HF 181. This is a bill for an act relating to the legislative review of administrative rules, and rescinding all rules every five years. After stating his opening remarks, and hearing remarks by other members of the committee, Representative Grassley moved HF 181; the bill was carried 13-8. Representatives Thomas, Hall, Heddens, Jacoby, Miller, Running-Marquardt, Steckman and Wittneben were opposed. The bill will move to the House floor as a committee bill. Acting Chair Hanusa returned the Chair to Representative Grassley.

Chair Grassley recognized Representative Smith for opening remarks on HF 263. This is a bill for an act requiring regulatory analysis for new administrative rules regarding the impact of the rules on small business. Following his opening remarks on the main bill, Representative Smith gave opening remarks on Amendment 854, a substantive amendment for HF 263. After hearing comments from the committee and offering his closing comments. Representative Smith then moved Amendment 854; the amendment was carried unanimously on a voice vote.

After offering closing remarks, Representative Smith moved HF 263; the bill was carried 21-0. The bill will move to the House floor as a committee bill.

With no further business to come before the meeting, Representative De Boef moved for adjournment and the motion was unanimously carried.

The committee adjourned at 5:30 PM.
