As there were no corrections, amendments, and/or deletions to the previous meeting minutes, Representative Dolecheck moved to approve the minutes as distributed.

Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Hein for opening comments on HF 369, a bill for an act relating to pseudorables testing. Representative Hein introduced Amendment 919 to HF 369. Following discussion, Amendment 919 passed by voice vote. Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Hein for HF 369 as amended. Following discussion, Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Hein for closing comments on HF 369 as amended. Representative Hein moved HF 369, a record roll call was taken, and HF 369 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House as a committee bill, 22-0, 1 absent (Rasmussen).

Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening comments on HF 292, A bill for an act relating to requests for agency action involving rules affecting livestock production, and including effective date provisions. Following discussion, Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Dolecheck for closing comments on HF 292. Representative Dolecheck moved HF 292, a recored roll call was taken, and HF 292 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House as a committee bill, 19-3(Hanson, Isenhart, Swaim), 1 absent (Rasmussen).

Chair Sweeney turned the meeting over to Vice-Chair Hein who recognized Representative Sweeney for opening comments on HSB 109, an act relating to ethanol by providing for tax credits and reporting for ethanol blended gasoline, and including effective date and applicability provisions. Following discussion, Vice-Chair Hein recognized Representative Sweeney for closing comments on HSB 109. Representative Sweeney moved HSB 109, a record roll call was taken, and HSB 109 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House as a committee bill, 22-0, 1 absent(Rasmussen).

Vice-Chair Hein turned the meeting back over to Chair Sweeney for continuation.
