

COMMITTEE MINUTES for LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Senator Wilhelm called the meeting to order at 9:40 am. Attendance was taken and minutes from the previous meeting were approved. The committee recessed for Democratic and Republican caucuses.

When the committee reconvened, Senator Wilhelm recognized Senator Schoenjahn for SF 98. Senator Schoenjahn made opening remarks and introduced amendment 751 to SF 98. It passed committee by a short form vote with Senator Hamerlinck voting nay. Roll call vote on SF 98 as amended was 4 aye, 5 nay, 1 present and 1 absent. Senator Quirmbach made a motion to reconsider.

Senator Wilhelm recognized Senator Quirmbach for SF 305. Opening remarks and discussion followed. Roll call vote was 7 aye, 4 nay. SF 305 moves to the calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Wilhelm turned the chair over to Senator Beall who recognized Senator Wilhelm for SSB 1178. Senator Wilhelm made opening remarks and introduced amendment 931. The amendment was accepted unanimously by a short form vote. SSB 1178 as amended was passed unanimously by a short form vote. It moves to the calendar under rule 40 as a committee bill.

Senator Beall then recognized Senator Wilhelm for SSB 1181. Senator Wilhelm asked the committee to consider SSB 1181 as a subcommittee of the whole. The subcommittee of the whole passed the bill unanimously by short form. The committee then passed the bill unanimously by short form vote without recommendation.

Senator Beall then turned the chair back to Senator Wilhelm who called up SF 98 again. A roll call vote was taken with 7 aye and 4 nay.

Senator Beall moved to arise at 10:30 am.
