



Hein recognized Representative Sweeney for closing comments on HSB 203. Representative Sweeney moved HSB 203, a record roll call was taken, and HSB 203 passed moving the bill to the House floor as a committee bill, 23-0.

Vice-Chair Hein turned the meeting back over to Chair Sweeney for continuation.

With unanimous consent, the committee dissolved into subcommittee as a whole for consideration of HSB 209, a bill for creating a committee to provide for greater collaboration between urban and rural communities. Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Miller for opening comments. Following discussion, Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Miller for closing comments on HSB 209. Representative Miller moved HSB 209, and the bill passed out of subcommittee with voice vote. Representative Sweeney moved to dissolve subcommittee as a whole and move back to full committee.
