Representative Forristall (Ch) recognized Representative Hanusa for introductory remarks on SF 445 ( a bill for an act relating to state and local government recommendations concerning the educational needs of children who are deaf or hard-of-hearing--Formerly SF 190). Hearing no discussion Representative Forristall recognized Representative Hanusa for closing comments on SF 445, and Representative Hanusa moved the bill for passage.

SF 445 passed out of committee on a Roll Call vote with 13 Ayes--Representatives Forristall, J. Taylor, Willems, Byrnes, Chambers, Cohoon, Cownie, Dolecheck, Gaines, Hanson, Hanusa, Kelley, and Sweeney. 10 members were absent and not voting--Representatives Abdul-Samad, Jorgensen, Koester, Lofgren, Mascher, L.
