Chair Baudler called the meeting to order at 3:05PM.

Roll call was taken and a quorum was present. Representatives Shaw and Brandenburg were excused.

As there were no corrections, amendments, and/or deletions to the March 17th meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Chair Baudler recognized Representative Worthan for SF 456. This is a bill for an act relating to persons prohibited from possessing or receiving firearms because of mental health commitments or adjudications and to petitions for relief from such prohibitions. Representative Worthan then gave opening remarks on SF 456. After answering questions from the committee, Representative Worthan moved SF 456. This Senate File was voted on and passed unanimously 19-0 with 2 absent, and will be moved to House floor.

The chair recognized Representative Hagenow for opening remarks on SF 236. This is a bill for an act relating to the practices and procedures of the department of public safety including the state fire service and emergency response council, the state building code commissioner, fingerprint records, disposition records, the sex offender registry, and access to deferred judgment docket records. After answering questions from the committee Representative Hagenow gave closing comments. He moved the bill and SF 236 was voted on and passed unanimously 19-0, with 2 absent. This bill will move to the House floor.

As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Olson, R. moved we adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 3:30PM.
