The State Government Committee was called to order by Chair Cownie at 10:10 a.m.

Roll call was dispensed at the start of the meeting.

Chair Cownie asked for any revisions to the minutes of the March 29th meeting. Hearing none, Chair Cownie moved to approve the minutes and the motion was unanimously carried.

Both parties went to caucus at 10:11 a.m.

The committee reconvened at 10:41 a.m.

Chair Cownie recognized Representative Koester for opening remarks on SF 430: A bill for an act relating to violations of the open records and public meetings laws and the creation of the Iowa public information board, and including fee and effective date provisions. (Formerly SF 246.) Discussion followed and with closing remarks moved SF 430 on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 21 ayes, 1 nay, (Hunter) 1 absent (Quirk).

Representative Iverson was recognized for opening remarks on SF 490: A bill for an act authorizing and regulating savings promotion drawings, and granting licensing authority to the department of inspections and appeals. (Formerly SSB 1019.)

Chair Cownie recognized Representative Raecker for amendment .2156, short form was called and amendment .2156 was adopted. Rep. Raecker asked permission to take up amendment .2157. Discussion followed and with closing remarks moved amendment .2157 on a roll call vote. Amendment .2157 failed. Rep Iverson gave closing comments and moved SF 490 as amended as a committee bill on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 15 ayes: Representative Cownie, Lensing, Drake, Gaskill, Hunter, Isenhart, Iverson, Kajtazovic, Koester, Mascher, Massie, Rogers, Schulte, Taylor T., and Wenthe.7 Nays: Representative Vander Linden, Hein, Helland, Jorgensen, Kaufmann, Pettengill, Raecker. 1 absent: Quirk.

Representative Iverson was recognized for opening remarks on SF 471: A bill for an act relating to the review of administrative rules and application processes. (Formerly SF 179.) Discussion followed and with closing remarks moved SF 471 on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 22 ayes, 1 absent.

Chair Cownie recognized Representative Wenthe for other business. Discussion followed on SF 364.

Chair Cownie gave closing remarks and thanked committee members for all their hard work.

With no further business to come before the Committee, Chair Cownie moved for adjournment and the motion was unanimously carried.
