The chair recognized Representative Grassley for opening remarks on HF 636. A bill for an act relating to urban revitalization areas by authorizing a property tax exemption for certain vacant commercial property, and including effective date provisions. A bill relating to the administration of the redevelopment tax credit program for brownfields and grayfields and including retroactive applicability provisions. The chair then recognized Representative Grassley for Amendment 2783. The amendment was moved and passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote of 25 to 0. The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate File as amended.
