House Study Bill 244, An Act relating to tax rates for employers with inactive accounts under the state unemployment compensation law. Representative Baltimore Chair, Representative Pettengill, Representative Kressig

House Study Bill 245, An Act allowing criminal history background checks for certain food vendors. Representative Pettengill chair, Representative Baltimore, Representative Berry

House Study Bill 246, An Act providing an exemption from the sales tax for the 1 furnishing of environmental testing services. Representative Hagenow Chair, Representative Tjepkes, Representative Berry
