Chairman Sands called the meeting to order at 10:54am. Attendance was taken and a quorum was present. As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the May 2nd meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

The chair recognized Representative Hein for opening remarks on SF 530 and entered into a subcommittee of the whole. There was discussion on the bill which would expand the eligible entities for the family farm property tax credit.

The bill was moved out of the subcommittee of the whole on a voice vote (short form.)

The subcommittee was dissolved and SF 530 was taken up in full committee. The Chair recognized Representative Hein again for opening remarks.

The bill was moved and a record roll call vote was taken. The bill passed 24-0 with one absent.

The chair then recognized Representative Byrnes for opening comments on SF 516 ? an act relating to solar and wind energy systems.

The chair recognized Representative Byrnes for opening comments on amendment 2617. Representative Byrnes moved the amendment and it was adopted on a voice vote (short form).

The bill as amended was moved and passed with 22 yes votes, 1 R-76 (Rep. Forristall) and two absents (Rep. De Boef and Rep. Helland) There was no additional business to come before the committee and Representative Muhlbauer moved we adjourn at 11:10am
