Representative Raecker called the Appropriations Committee to order at 9:00 AM. Roll was called and a quorum was present. Minutes from the May 2, 2011 meeting were approved.

Representative Raecker requested and received consent to dissolve the committee into a subcommittee of the whole. The Chair then recognized Representative Wagner for opening remarks on SF 533, an Act relating to state and local finances by providing for funding of property tax credits and reimbursement, by making and adjusting appropriations providing for salaries and compensation of state employees, providing for matters relating to tax credits, providing for fees and penalties, providing for legal responsibilities, and providing for properly related matters, and including effective date and retroactive and other applicability provisions. With no further comments, Representative Wagner moved the bill, which passed, short form.

Representative Raecker requested and received consent to dissolve the subcommittee of the whole and return to the full committee.

The Chair recognized Representative Wagner for opening remarks on SF 533. Seeing none, the Chair recognized Representative for opening remarks on Amendment 533.3142.

The Chair recognized Representative Murphy for opening remarks on Amendment 533.3142.3146. Following comments, Representative Murphy moved the amendment, which failed, 0-24.

The Chair returned committee discussion to Amendment 533.3142. Following further comments and questions, Representative Raecker recognized Representative Wagner for closing comments. Representative Wagner moved the amendment, which passed, short form.

Representative Raecker returned committee discussion to SF 533 and recognized Representative Olson for comments. The Chair recognized Representative Wagner for closing comments on SF 533 and Representative Wagner moved the bill, which passed 14-10.

Representative Raecker offered final remarks to the committee and thanked the committee members and staff for their work this session.
