A presentation was given by Director Jason Glass and Deputy Director Kevin Fangman on ESEA waiver. Questions from committee members were answered.

Rep. Forristall (Ch) announced a subcommittee of the whole. After unanimous consent, the meeting was moved to a subcommittee of the whole, and SF 468 was passed out of subcommittee of the whole unanimously in short form. Rep.
