Representative Raecker requested and received unanimous consent to dissolve the committee into a subcommittee of the whole for consideration of SF 2007, a bill for an act making appropriation to the college student aid commission for purposes of the national guard educational assistance program and including effective date provisions. The Chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks. Comments followed. Representative Dolecheck moved the bill, which passed out of subcommittee unanimously, short form.

Representative Raecker requested and received unanimous consent to dissolve the subcommittee of the whole and return to the full committee. The Chair then recognized Representative Dolecheck who moved the bill, which passed 21-0.

Representative Raecker requested and received unanimous consent to dissolve the committee into a subcommittee of the whole for consideration of SF 2018, a bill for an act relating to financial assistance for purposes of the battleship Iowa, BB-61, making appropriations, and including effective date provisions. The Chair recognized Representative Lukan for opening remarks. Following discussion, Representative Lukan moved the bill, which passed out of subcommittee unanimously, short form.

Representative Raecker requested and received unanimous consent to dissolve the subcommittee of the whole and return to the full committee. The Chair then recognized Representative Lukan who, following further questions, moved the bill. SF 2018 passed 21-0.
