Representative Taylor moved SF 93. SF 93 passed the Judiciary Committee 16-2, with 3 absent. Those voting nay were Representatives Wolfe and Massie. Those absent were Representatives Oldson, Olson, T., and Swaim. Chair Anderson announced that SF 93, having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as Senate File 93.

Chair Anderson announced that HSB 513 and HSB 524 will be considered at the next meeting.
