Upon completion of the caucuses at 4:35 PM, Rep. Soderberg recognized Rep. Chip Baltimore for an introduction of HSB 556. Following discussion, Rep. Soderberg recognized Rep. Baltimore for closing comments. Rep. Baltimore then moved the bill. Roll was called.
