The State Government Committee was called to order by Chair Cownie at 4:05 p.m.

Roll call was taken with a quorum present.

Chair Cownie asked for any revisions to the minutes of the February 2nd meeting. Hearing none, Chair Cownie moved to approve the minutes as printed.

Chair Cownie gave opening remarks and announced the following (5) bill assignments:

Chair Cownie recognizes Representative Iverson for opening remarks on HSB 521. A study bill relating to the licensure of ambulatory surgical centers, providing fees and penalties, and including effective date provisions. The subcommittee report was submitted and signed by Rep. Iverson, Helland and Mascher. Rep. Iverson gave opening remarks and asked permission to take up amendment 521.3686. Discussion followed and Amendment 521.3686 passed short form. Rep. Iverson gave closing remarks and moved HSB 521 as amended. Chair Cownie moved HSB 521, as a committee bill with fiscal note to the calendar on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 23 ayes.

Chair Cownie recognizes Representative Schulte for opening remarks on HSB 523. A study bill relating to the regulation of persons offering occupational therapy services. The subcommittee report was submitted and signed by Rep. Schulte, Rogers and T. Taylor. Rep. Schulte gave opening remarks and asked permission to take up amendment 523.3614. Discussion followed and Amendment 523.3614 passed short form. Rep. Schulte gave closing remarks and moved HSB 523 as amended. Chair Cownie moved HSB 523, as a committee bill to the calendar on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 23 ayes.

With no further business to come before the Committee, Chair Cownie moved for adjournment. Representative Hunter seconded the motion.
